Soundcheck:

To take place between 18.00 and 19.00. Rig up and run sound (NB: The sound check is not a practice). It is not possible to come before opening hours. Sound of Mu can provide a sound engineer / technician for a fee. If you need a sound engineer / technician, let us know in good time via program (at) soundofmu.no

"Behaviour":

Concerts have to be finished by 23:00. As Sound of Mu is a small place, you should always try to take equipment down immediately after you finish playing - but a pint and some fresh air "to land" before you start dismantling is, of course, okay. You must also take all the gear with you when you go, because there is no space for it (for out-of-town bands we can make a special agreement but only by prior arrangement).

Money:

Since all of the entrance fee goes to you the artist, you should arrange for someone who can sit by the door to take in the money - unless you want to hold free concert. Unfortunately, we can not offer free drinks to the band.

Other:

Most of our audience is very polite, in fact they are often so courteous and have so much respect that they are not even getting up to buy a beer during the concert. Since all entry money goes to you in the band, obviously we need to sell lots of beer. Therefore we encourage all of you artists who play with us to include either a good old drinking song in the set-list, or to have a break midway. NB! Sound of Mu do not have permission for outdoor seating on the footpath in front, so drinking must take place indoors.
